By integrating **veterinary medicine, animal-assisted therapy, and education under one roof**, the project seeks to demonstrate that compassion can be both **sustainable and scalable** — restoring well-being, inspiring communities, and protecting life in all its forms.

The Model

Health Center

Veterinary & shelter care + child therapy zone

Mobile Clinic

“Healing on Wheels” outreach for rescue, spay/neuter, and education

Preventive Wellness Plans

Subscription-based care ensuring sustainability

“Esperanza for Life” Center – Plovdiv, Bulgaria

A 400–600 m² facility combining:

- A **veterinary clinic** for essential and specialized care
- A **small rescue & adoption zone** (15–25 animals)
- A **therapy & education area** where children can heal and grow through interaction with animals

Mobile Clinic – “Healing on Wheels”

A custom-fitted vehicle extending the Center’s reach to underserved areas, offering:

- Spay/neuter and vaccination campaigns
- Emergency rescue and outreach care
- Mobile therapy visits and educational programs

Preventive Wellness Plans

A subscription-based preventive care system providing stable recurring income while promoting responsible pet ownership and long-term animal health.

Funding & Partnership Model

Estimated Year 1 Budget: €500,000 – €1.5 million

Operational Sustainability: Targeted within 24–30 months

Funding Mix:

- Founding Patrons Circle (major donors & sponsors)
- Corporate investors and CSR partnerships (equity, convertible notes, or in-kind support)
- Philanthropic grants & EU social innovation funding
- Revenue from clinic services, therapy programs, and wellness plans

The **TvA International Foundation** will remain the **majority shareholder** in the corporate entity *Esperanza for Life Corp.*, ensuring long-term mission alignment and transparency.

Impact Metrics

Animal Welfare Impact

- 300+ animals rescued and treated annually
- 85%+ adoption or rehabilitation success rate
- Monthly spay/neuter & vaccination campaigns reducing stray populations

Child & Community Impact

- 100+ children in therapy and education programs annually
- Increased emotional resilience and empathy through measurable outcomes
- 50+ community volunteers and local partners engaged

Environmental & Economic Impact

- 10–12 new local jobs created
- Minimum 30% of operational costs covered through service income by year 2
- Strengthened local economies and humane community development

Visibility & Brand Impact

- Global storytelling and awareness through *Esperanza for Life – A Celebration of Life* events, Foundation concerts, and media partnerships



Next Steps & Expansion Roadmap

Phase I – Pilot Launch (Plovdiv, 2026)

- Secure and renovate facility
- Deploy mobile clinic
- Establish partnerships with universities, child development experts, and NGOs

Phase II – Regional Scaling (2026–2028)

- Replicate Centers in **Sofia** and **Varna**
- Expand with 2–3 mobile vet clinics for rural outreach
- Partner with ministries and local governments

Phase III – Southeast Europe Expansion (2028–2030)

- Establish Centers in **Romania, Serbia, North Macedonia, and Greece**
- Form *Esperanza for Life Network Alliance* for shared data, training, and funding

Phase IV – Global Integration (2030 and beyond)

- Set up a **Central Coordination & Training Hub** (Vienna or Sofia)
- Launch **Esperanza for Life Impact Fund** for blended financing
- Develop franchise/licensing model for replication worldwide
